Unit 12 Chain game cards (p. 175, 5d)

Procedure: Download and print two copies of this sheet. Keep one sheet intact so you can help the learners if there are problems. Cut out the cards on the second sheet, mix them up, and give out all the cards to the students. If there are fewer than 16 learners in the class, some will get more than one card. Ask learners to read the information on the cards and check for understanding. The teacher begins the game by opening a book. The student with the first card should then go to the board as described on his or her card. The chain continues as each learner carries out the action described on the cards.
